This intensive four-year program asks students to explore the philosophical, ethical, and aesthetic dimensions of the human experience. We expect our students to become socially conscious, responsible leaders in our transforming world. ACADEMICS

- Four-year course of study in science, math, English, and history; three years of Spanish; all of our classes are taught at the Honors level.
- Students interested in visual arts can complete a three year art sequence, taking art in 10th grade and Advanced Art in 11th & 12th grade.
- Four-year Advisory: students set and monitor their academic goals through advisory; senior institute (college applications support)
- Senior Courses: exit project (defended before a panel); internships; senior mentors, dual-credited college calculus in partnership with Baruch College
- Mentoring; electives vary annually and have included Tech Team, Current Affairs, Writing, Computer Science, Art
